All the information & data are presented systematically & meaningful in descriptive type & also using maps.

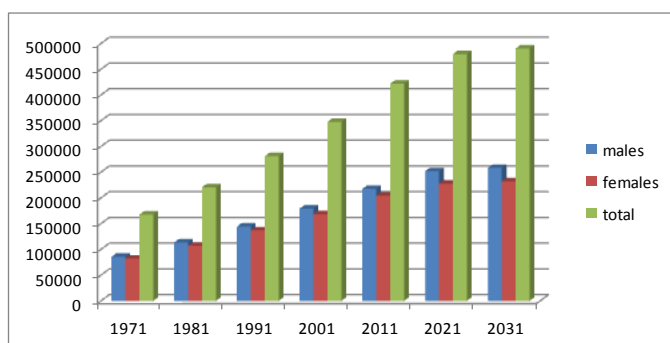
## Results and discussion
